May 23 — **Katy Mike Smaistria** will bring us information on the work of **EarthWays Center** and how we might make our own lives greener.

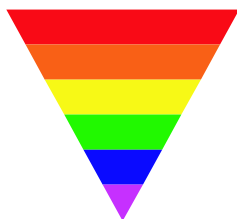
